461-105-0410 Effective 7-01-23 Requirement to Cooperate in Quality Control Review; REF, REFM, SNAP, and TANF

- (1) In the REF, REFM, SNAP, and TANF programs, individuals are required to cooperate in the Department's quality control review process.
- (2) In the REF, REFM, and TANF programs, an individual who refuses to cooperate is ineligible for the program in which the review takes place until the individual cooperates.
- (3) In the SNAP program, if an individual refuses to cooperate, the individual's *filing group* (see OAR <u>461-110-0370</u>) is ineligible for the program. The individual may choose to cooperate at any time. If the SNAP benefits have not already closed, the *filing group* does not need to reapply. The *filing group*, upon filing a new application, may again be found eligible only in accordance with federal SNAP program regulations in 7 CFR 273.2(d)(2).
